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DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MAY 21, 2024

A. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Board Meeting of May 21, 2024, of the Delta Farms Water Control District (the "District") was called to order at 8:07 a.m. in the offices of Carter Associates located at 1708 21st Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that showed notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Indian River Press Journal* on October 6, 2023, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Sakuma stated that the attendance of Supervisors Rusty Banack, Tim Dooley and Brian Randolph constituted a quorum, and it was in order for the meeting to proceed.

Also in attendance were District Managers Frank Sakuma and Stephanie Brown of Special District Services, Inc.; and District Engineer Tyler Spencer of Carter Associates.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. April 16, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

The April 16, 2024, Regular Board Meeting minutes were approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Banack, and the **motion** passed unanimously.

G. REPORTS

1. Treasurer

Mr. Banack went over the financial data provided in the Board package with the Supervisors. After further discussion, the May 21st Treasurer's Report was approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Randolph, and the **motion** passed unanimously.

2. Engineer

Mr. Spencer discussed the engineering report, which was provided under separate cover. He requested consideration of a proposal from R&S for a pump station repair. After further discussion, Mr. Banack made a **motion**, seconded by Mr. Dooley, and passed unanimously approving the proposal from R&S in the amount of \$25,014.00 for a pump station repair.

3. Attorney

There was no Attorney Report at this time.

4. Chairman

There was no Chairman Report at this time.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update on Kromhout Request

Mr. Sakuma notified the Board that the request was still in progress and that Mr. Kromhout stated that he would be sending a check within the next week to the District's Attorney.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion Regarding Mowing

Ms. Colella suggested a vendor that she had used previously for mowing.

After discussion, the Board consensus was for Mr. Spencer to send out an RFP for future mowing of the District common areas.

2. Consider Resolution No. 2024-01 Adopting Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Proposed Budget

Resolution No. 2024-01 was presented, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Sakuma advised that the FY 2024/2025 Proposed Budget was included in the Board package. Mr. Randolph suggested instituting a capital reserve line item as well as creating a capital improvement project list to assist with scheduling capital improvements/replacements. Mr. Dooley suggested lowering "Repairs" to \$20,000, "Reserves" to \$0, and to reduce the assessment rate. The Board consensus was to set the assessment rate to (\$88 per acre) and make up the difference with carryover from FY 2023/2024.

After further discussion, Mr. Dooley made a **motion**, seconded by Mr. Banack, and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2024-01, Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Proposed Budget as amended and setting the Public Hearing for August 20, 2024.

3. Discussion Regarding Conservation Easement Enhancements

Ms. Colella asked for recommendations from the Board for the best elevation to properly drain into the B Canal.

4. Discussion Regarding SE Entrance Gate

This item was not discussed.

J. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

There were no administrative matters.

There were no Board Member comments.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT TO BE TRANSFERRED; DETERMINING TRANSFER OF THE REAL PROPERTY TO ALEXANDRA KROMHOUT, TRUSTEE OF THE ALEXANDER KROMHOUT REVOCABLE TRUST DATED DECEMBER 14, 2009 (GRANTEE) TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE DISTRICT AND THE PUBLIC; APPROVING, ACCEPTING, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A QUIT-CLAIM DEED FOR TRANSFER TO THE GRANTEE; APPROVING TRANSFER OF THE REAL PROPERTY TO THE GRANTEE, SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING BOARD OFFICERS, THE DISTRICT MANAGER, DISTRICT ENGINEER, ATTORNEYS, AND OTHER AGENTS OF THE BOARD TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors ("Board") of the Delta Farms Water Control District ("District"), has made the following determinations:

- **A.** In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 298, *Florida Statutes*, this Board is responsible for the construction, operation, and maintenance of canals, ditches, drains, levees, lakes, ponds, and other works for water management and control purposes within the District.
- **B.** § 298.22, Fla. Stat. (2024) grants to the Board the power, among other matters, to "acquire, construct, operate, maintain, use, purchase, sell, lease, convey, or transfer real or personal property."
- C. In April 2023, this Board received a request from Lex Kromhout to transfer approximately 1.17 acres of District land (Real Property) on which his driveway has been located for over seventy years.
- **D.** The Board has determined that Real Property is no longer necessary, used, useful, or appropriate for the location and operation by the Board for canal or other drainage facilities so long as the District receives an appropriate easement for access for the purpose of maintaining and improving any existing roads, ditches, canals or other works of the District located upon the conveyed property, and an easement for access over, upon and under the conveyed property to any utility lines, systems and installations and the right to connect thereto.
- **E.** In an open meeting of the Board held on August 20, 2024, the District Manager recommended that the Board approve the transfer of the Real Property to the Grantee.
- **F.** The best interests of the District will be served by (i) determining that transfer to the Grantee is in the best interest of the District and the public; (ii) approving and authorizing execution of the Quit-Claim Deed to the Grantee in the form attached to this Resolution; (iii) authorizing and directing the Board Officers, District Manager, District Engineer, attorneys, and

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other agents of the Board to do all things necessary to carry out the transactions contemplated by this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Delta Farms Water Control District, as follows:

- 1. <u>Declaration of Real Property as Unnecessary</u>. The Real Property is hereby declared to be unnecessary for the location and operation by the Board for canal or other drainage facilities so long as the District receives an appropriate easement for access for the purpose of maintaining and improving any existing roads, ditches, canals or other works of the District located upon the conveyed property, and an easement for access over, upon and under the conveyed property to any utility lines, systems and installations and the right to connect thereto.
- 2. <u>Determination that Transfer is in Best Interest of District and Public</u>. The Board hereby determines that transfer of the Real Property to the Grantee is in the best interest of the District and the public.
- **3.** Approval of and Authorization to Execute the Quit-Claim Deed. The Board hereby approves and authorizes execution of the Quit-Claim Deed (Deed) between the Board and the Grantee in substantially the form attached to this Resolution.
- 4. <u>Approval of Transfer of Real Property to Purchaser; Conditions.</u> The transfer the Real Property to the Grantee, including execution and delivery of a Deed conveying the Real Property to the Grantee, be, and it is hereby, approved, subject to the terms, conditions, and contingencies set forth in the Deed, including but not limited to reserving appropriate easements over the Real Property.
- 5. Authorization and Direction for Officers to Act. Members of the Board, the District Manager, officers, attorneys, and other agents of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and things required of them by this Resolution for the full, punctual, and complete performance of the terms, covenants, and agreements contained herein or therein, and each member, officer, attorney, and agent of the Board is further authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers and instruments and to cause to be done any and all acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out the transactions contemplated under this Resolution and the Deed including, but not limited to, approving modifications thereto, and to related documents, provided, however, that no such modification shall materially alter the nature or extent of this Resolution or the Deed.

Grantor District reserves an easement for access for the purpose of maintaining and improving any existing roads, ditches, canals or other works of the District located upon the conveyed property; provided, however, that Grantor District shall have no obligation to maintain or make improvements. Additionally, Grantor District reserves for itself and property owners within the District an easement for access over, upon and under the conveyed property to any utility lines, systems and installations and the right to connect thereto.

Grantee is specifically conferred the power and authority (1) either to protect, conserve and to sell, or to lease, or to encumber, or otherwise manage and dispose of the real property herein described; and (2) all of the powers and authority which could be granted or conferred under the authorization and powers permitted to be conferred and granted pursuant to Chapter 689.073, Florida Statutes.

Subject to taxes for the year 2024 and subsequent years and easements and restrictions of record, if any; however, this reference shall not serve to reimpose same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest, lien, equity and claim whatsoever of the said first party, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said second party forever.
