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DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 15, 2024

A. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Board Meeting of October 15, 2024, of the Delta Farms Water Control District (the "District") was called to order at 8:15 a.m. in the offices of Carter Associates located at 1708 21st Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that showed notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Indian River Press Journal* on September 30, 2024, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Sakuma stated that the attendance of Supervisors Rusty Banack, Tim Dooley, and Brian Randolph (via phone @ 8:19am) constituted a quorum, and it was in order for the meeting to proceed.

Also in attendance were District Managers Frank Sakuma and Stephanie Brown, of Special District Services, and District Engineer Tyler Spencer of Carter Associates.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. August 20, 2024, Regular Board Meeting & Public Hearing Minutes

The August 20, 2024, Regular Board Meeting and Public Hearing minutes were approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Banack. The **motion** passed unanimously.

G. **REPORTS**

1. Treasurer

Mr. Banack went over the financial data provided in the Board package with the Supervisors. He discussed reallocating a portion of the money market account funds and notified the Board that he would bring back options for consideration.

After further discussion, the October 15th Treasurer's Report was approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Randolph. The **motion** passed unanimously.

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2. Engineer

Mr. Spencer notified the Board that there is no report on the west levee at this time. He stated that remote rain gauges have been ordered and the process to find solenoid parts for the fuel line is ongoing. Mr. Dooley requested staff confirm that the remote rain gauges have a 1-year warranty. Mr. Randolph suggested contacting additional vendors to address the solenoid issue and speak with Palmdale regarding alternate solutions if parts are not available.

3. Attorney

There was no Attorney Report at this time.

4. Chairman

There was no Chairman Report at this time.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Discussion Regarding Resolution No. 2024-05

Resolution No. 2024-05 was presented entitled:
